

TOWN OF HOWLAND

DISBURSEMENT WARRANT POLICY

Section 1. Purpose

The purpose of this Policy is to provide an alternative to the statutory procedure for approval of warrants authorizing the treasurer to disburse money.

Section 2. Authority

This Policy is enacted pursuant to 30-A, M.R.S.A., §3001 (Municipal Home Rule) and §5603(2)(A).


Section 3. Procedure for Approval

The Treasurer may disburse money only on the authority of a warrant drawn for the purpose, either, 1) affirmatively voted and signed by a majority of the municipal officers at a duly called public meeting, 2) seen and signed by a majority of the municipal officers acting individually and separately or, 3) signed as otherwise provided by law for the disbursement of employees' wages and benefits and payment of municipal education costs.




